Caged CONquest is expanding on Social Media sites and striving to get the word out about inmate art and get people to visit the site www.cagedconquest.com. Artwork also keeps coming in which generates new items for our customers and visitors to view and purchase.



We have been receiving pieces of artwork on folded, crumpled, ragged pieces of lined notebook paper that is not of artistic quality and that does not scan and transfer well onto Print On Demand products. It's understandable that it can be tough to get good paper and supplies at some facilities, but strive to make sure whatever you're drawing is at least on a smooth piece of paper without lines/holes/tears/smudges in the background (unless that is actually part of the art). If possible, send your designs without them being folded to fit in the envelope (i.e., get a larger envelope).

DO NOT send photocopies of artwork – we cannot sell or do anything with copies; we only will deal with artist's original pieces of art.

DO NOT send anything other than artwork done on canvas, paper, Bristol, card stock and the like. A number of inmates have inquired about selling leatherwork, ceramics and crafts; at this time we are only working with artwork. If and when we expand to other mediums we will send out a notice and mention it in our newsletter.

Artist's Requests

Some artists have been sending ideas and suggestions for where and how they would like their artwork displayed (such as on a mug or a hoodie or with a specific type of model, etc.). We will always do our best to accommodate and take into consideration your ideas, but realize many factors are in play and we'll do the best we can on this side of the fence.

OPTIMAL ARTWORK SIZE

New artwork continues to arrive every week. Our office scanner is only 8.25" X 11.5", so keep that in mind for your smaller projects and to give room for margins. Larger pieces of artwork are outsourced to be scanned so will take a little longer to be get posted to the website.

Our website www.cagedconquest.com has gone through major upgrades for optimal exposure for our artists. If you haven't sent a bio and photo, make it a point to do so and it will link to your catalog of artwork being sold on the Caged Art store.

CAGED ART

The more artists' works we have, the more new customers we'll draw to the site, so pass on the word about the potential and have anyone wanting a brochure or newsletter to send us a letter with their information.

CAGED AUTHORS

More incarcerated authors are sending us links to their published books and are getting listed on the website. For any published authors, we are posting their book covers and information and listing links to their books to draw traffic to them. For those incarcerated authors who are not yet published, send us your information and we'll keep you posted when we are in a position to help you get published as well as other writing opportunities that may appear.

DO NOT send us any poetry or short stories or chapters to a book you're working on; we can do nothing with such things at this time. We will eventually work with unpublished authors, just not equipped to do so right now.

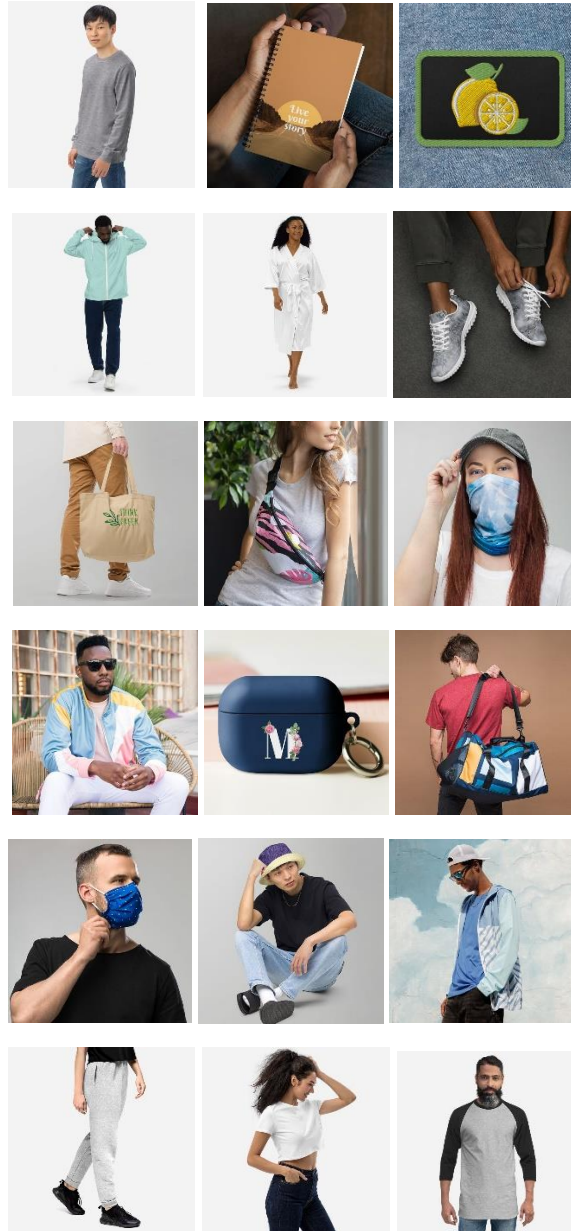
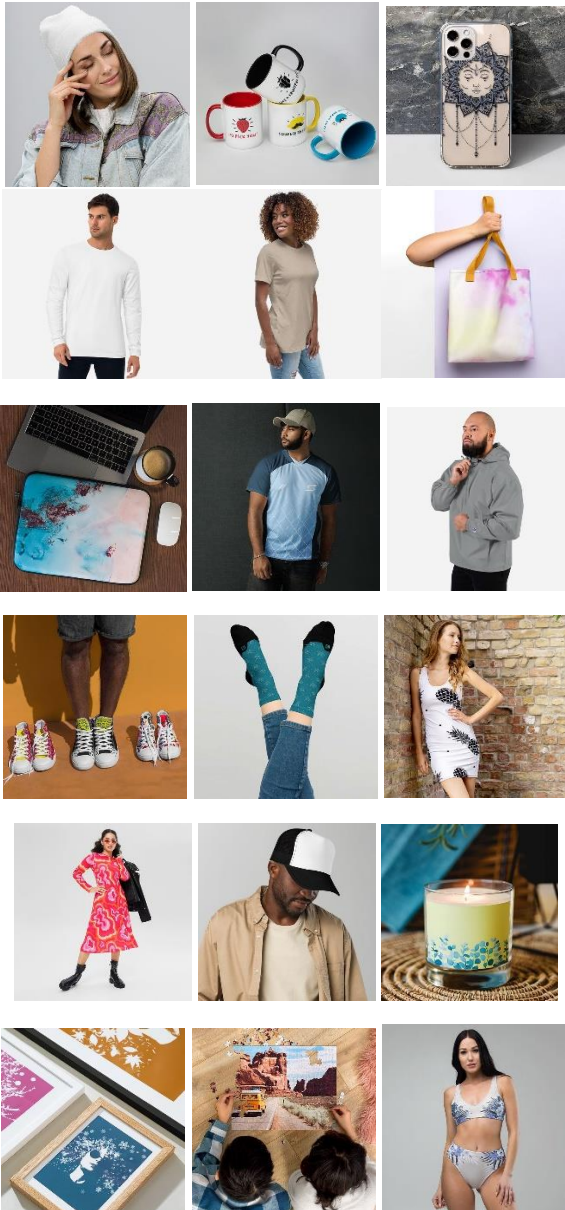

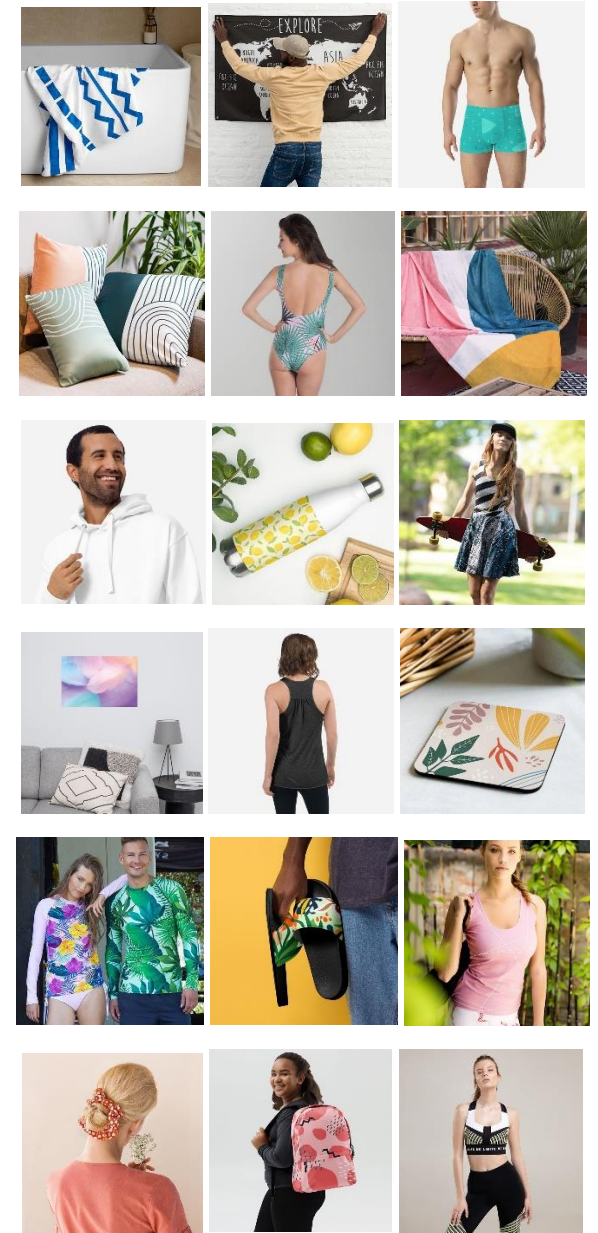
